How Do CalFresh Benefits Work?



Each month, funds are deposited directly into your CalFresh account for use with your CalFresh card.



Use your CalFresh card at checkout by swiping, choosing EBT, and entering your PIN to complete the purchase.

- Proof of Living Expenses: rent, utilities, phone, childcare, or medical bills
